- <u>Stancil v. Superior Court (Redwood City)</u>, (2021) 11 Cal.5th 381 Prepared successful brief submitted to California Supreme Court arguing that motions to quash service of summons and complaint may not challenge merits of unlawful detainer complaints.
- <u>Friends of Riverside Airport v. City of Riverside</u>: In ongoing federal court action concerning CERCLA and breach of contract issues, take deposition, prepare briefs, assist with expert report preparation, propound and respond to written discovery.
- <u>HC 650 LLC v. Starcity Properties</u>: In ongoing state court action concerning dispute over commercial lease agreement, take
