As society's outlooks shift and legislators evaluate future lawful uses of cannabis, employers must navigate an ever-changing legal landscape. And you'll receive guidance on policy updates and implementation based on the latest research on testing and impairment, to ensure your agency's testing policy meets constitutional constraints.
