## Burke Expands Public Law Practice with Addition of Longtime City Attorney Michael Barrett

Michael also counseled the City through its responses to several severe local emergencies including a major flood in 2005, a sizable earthquake in 2014, destructive wildfires in 2017, and impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Michael commented, "I look forward to collaborating with like-minded professionals to find and implement creative solutions to the challenges facing public agencies.
